Owens Corning Roofing and Asphalt LLC is the first roofing manufacturer to establish a program for recycling shingles. They connect contractors with convenient recycling facilities through a national strategic alliance with Earth911.com and Heritage Environmental Services.



As part of this groundbreaking program, Sheppard Roofing has taken the Preferred Contractor Shingle Recycling Pledge, committing to recycle our shingle tear-offs. We're committed to reducing waste, saving energy and building more durable products, and we've pledged to use a shingle recycling program that keeps your old roof out of the landfill!

Since the program began in 2009, 100,000 tons of shingles have been recycled, the equivalent of approximately 33,000 roofs. Every recycled roof is comparable to recycling more than 100 percent of a year's worth of household waste. Combined, the recycled shingles provided 100,000 barrels of oil in the form of asphalt typically reused in paving.
